Step 1: Collect These Documents

- Passport (valid at least 6 months beyond your intended stay)
- Form I-20 (issued by your school)
- DS-160 confirmation page
- SEVIS fee payment receipt
- Visa application fee receipt
- Recent passport-size photograph
- Proof of financial support
- Academic transcripts and test scores

Step 2: Complete the Application Process

- 1. Receive your Form I-20 from your SEVP-approved school.
- 2. Pay the SEVIS I-901 fee online.
- 3. Complete the DS-160 form and print the confirmation page.
- 4. Schedule and attend your visa interview at the U.S. embassy.
- 5. Provide biometric data if required.

Step 3: Prepare for Your Visa Interview

- Dress professionally and arrive early.
- Bring all required documents in a folder.
- Be honest and clear in your answers.
- Emphasize your intent to return home after your studies.
- Practice answering common questions like:
 - Why do you want to study in the U.S.?
- What will you study?
- Who is paying for your education?

- [] Prepare for your arrival and orientation
